22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

 19 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from
 20 the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund, for transfer by warrant into the
 21 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Public
 22 Employees' Retirement System to provide funds for the payment of retiree
 23 benefits of the Arkansas State Police Retirement System, the sum of
 24\$9,000,000.

4 established in the operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas
5 State Police, and may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated
6 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational
7 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.
8 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department
9 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
10 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
11 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
12 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

13 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
14 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

35 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement
36 funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be

1 used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for
2 the Department of Arkansas State Police.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
4 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

5
6 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
8 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
9 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
10 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
11 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
12 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
13 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the
14 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime
15 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
16 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
18 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

19
20 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
22 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
23 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
24 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.
25 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used
26 for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the maximum
27 number of authorized passenger vehicles.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
29 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

30
31 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM
33 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas
34 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer
35 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
36 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee

1 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the
2 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
3 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
4 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
5 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
6 department, the ~~86th~~ 87th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
7 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide
8 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public
9 employees insurance program.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
11 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

12
13 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
15 EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
16 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the
17 Operations Appropriation provided by in this Act, up to an amount not to
18 exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for
19 emergency purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during
20 emergency operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an
21 emergency, an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director,
22 to incur expenses for all deployed personnel.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009
24 through June 30, 2010.

25
26 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
29 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35
36 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
