23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
26 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2009-2010 fiscal
27 year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall
28 be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation
29 Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws
30 amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific
31 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
32 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
33 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
34 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
35 101), or its successor.

 30 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
 31 and Training, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief
 32 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Arkansas
 33 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Drug Detection for the
 34 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

10 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 12 FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of ~~appropriation and~~ funds authorized for
 13 Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010, shall be
 14 carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal
 15 year ending June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

16 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of ~~appropriation and/or~~ funding as
 17 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

18 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set
 19 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said ~~appropriation and/or~~
 20 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

21 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 22 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
 23 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
 24 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 25 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
 26 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
 27 and the amount of ~~the appropriation and/or~~ funding carried forward from the
 28 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
 29 the funding source ~~of that appropriation~~ and a copy of the written request
 30 set forth in (1) above;

31 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 32 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 33 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 34 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 35 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 36 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents

1 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
2 Committee; and

3 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
4 all information obtained in item (3) above in the ~~biennial~~-budget manuals
5 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
6 Institution.

7

8 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009
