- (2) Any <u>retirement</u> annuity <del>benefit formerly</del> <u>previously</u> due from the <u>Arkansas Teacher Retirement System</u> shall be terminated upon the effective date of the rescission.
- 9 (e)(1)(A) If reemployment a retirant who has elected to rescind his or

6	orderly system of benefits for the member of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement

9	become effective on July 1,2009.
