19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-10-103(c)(1)(E), concerning the*
22 *determination of qualified electors for the purposes of nonpartisan*
23 *elections, is amended to read as follows:*

24 *(E) In determining the number of qualified electors in the state*
25 *or in any court of appeals district, ~~or~~ circuit court circuit, or district*
26 *court district, the total number of all votes cast therein for Governor in*
27 *the immediately preceding general gubernatorial election shall be conclusive*
28 *of the number of all qualified electors therein for purposes of this section.*

30 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-10-103(c)(2)(D), concerning filing by*
31 *petition as a candidate for district judge is amended to read as follows:*

32 *(D) Candidates by petition for district judge shall file*
33 *petitions signed by at least ~~thirty (30) qualified electors who reside within~~*
34 *~~the district for which the candidate seeks office~~ one percent (1%) of the*
35 *qualified electors residing within the district for which the candidate seeks*



1 office, but in no event shall more than two thousand (2,000) signatures be
