(a) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2007-2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year a pool of twenty-five (25)no more than five (5) non-classified positions at a maximum salary level not to exceed one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) per year. These positions are to be used by the Department of Education in the event that the personal services needs of the Department during the 2007-2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year require additional positions, either by title or in number, that are not authorized by the General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act. These positions may also be used to properly classify positions when the Department does not have a vacant

- l position available with the appropriate title and salary level.
- 2 (b) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the
- 3 necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas
- 4 Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2007-
- 5 2009 biennium 2009-2010 fiscal year a pool of twenty-five (25) classified
- 6 positions at up to a grade twenty-six (26) C130. These positions are to be
- 7 used by the Department of Education in the event that the personal services
