15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL
16 SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2009-2010

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
24 Department of Rural Services for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Rural Services - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CONFERENCE EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Rural Services, for conference expenses of the Department of Rural Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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5 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
7 FAIR GRANTS. The Department of Rural Services shall develop the necessary
8 rules and regulations for the disbursement of matching fund grants to county
9 fairs for the construction, renovation and/or improvements to county fair
10 grounds. The grants shall be matched on a 50/50 basis. The match may be
11 cash or in-kind. No county fair shall receive more than \$30,000 for the
12 biennium.

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14 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANT
16 AWARD CRITERIA. The Department of Rural Services shall promulgate regulations
17 establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom grants will
18 be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and
19 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee,
20 the Department of Rural Services shall distribute the grants.
21 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
22 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
23 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
24 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
25 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
26 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
27 has determined that the Department of Rural Services may operate more
28 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Rural
29 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
30 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
31 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
32 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
34 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
35 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
36 this entire section is void.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 2 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

 4 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 14 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 23 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 25 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
