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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-10-309(a)(1)(A)(iv) is amended to read
22 as follows to change the punctuation to conform to Code style:

23 (iv) The Attorney General shall be allowed to
24 recover costs and attorney's fees associated with the civil suit from the
25 town, county, or city found to have failed to be in ~~compliance; and~~
26 compliance.
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28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-10-310(b) is amended to read as follows
29 *in light of the repeal of § 1-2-305 and to insert additional programs and*
30 *funds that also receive installments from the State Administration of Justice*

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10 SECTION 3. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal,
11 expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the 87th
12 General Assembly. All such acts shall have full effect and, so far as those
13 acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this
14 act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or
15 repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
