AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE
MILITARY DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 2010; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY
DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATION FOR THE
2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Military Department for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

1 shall be transferred or deposited the moneys to be provided by law for the
2 fund.

3 (2) The fund shall be used by the Military Department to pay
4 reimbursements for periodic, short term personnel augmentation for National
5 Guard Members on State Active Duty for cost incurred in training activities,
6 which shall include but not be limited to goods, supplies, rations, fuel,
7 operating expenses and related costs and expenses.

8 (b) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor
9 of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a fund to be known as the
10 Military Support Revolving Fund. The fund shall consist of:

11 (1) All funds provided for by law for the fund;

12 (2) All moneys received by the Military Department from the United
13 States Army, United States Air Force, United States Navy, Foreign Allied
14 Governments, and Reserve Forces of the United States, Allied Nations and
15 other federal agencies; and,

16 (3) Any and all reimbursements and payments to this fund from any
17 source shall be considered a refund to expenditures.

18 (4) As federal reimbursements replenish this fund, the Agency is
19 authorized to return funds, as necessary, to the Special Military Fund.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
21 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

23 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
25 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the State Military
26 Department shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount,
27 if any, of unexpended federal funds for the State Military Department - Youth
28 Challenge Program remaining in the State Military Department Fund. Such
29 amounts, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose in
30 the next succeeding fiscal year.

31 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of ~~appropriation and/or~~ funding as
32 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

33 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010 the Agency shall by written statement set
34 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said ~~appropriation and/or~~
35 funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

36 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

1 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward ~~from~~
 2 ~~the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the~~
 3 ~~biennium~~ by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 4 Committee meeting ~~in the second fiscal year of the biennial period~~ which
 5 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
 6 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward ~~from the~~
 7 ~~first fiscal year to the second fiscal year~~, the program name or line item,
 8 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
 9 set forth in (1) above;

10 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 11 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 12 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 13 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 14 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 15 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
 16 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 17 Committee; and

18 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
 19 all information obtained in item (3) above in the ~~biennial~~ budget manuals
 20 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
 21 Institution.

 23 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 24 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP.
 25 No employee of the Camp J.T. Robinson, or Fort Chaffee Federal Training Site
 26 Divisions of the Military Department who is employed as "extra help" may
 27 receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum annual
 28 salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-5-201
 29 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for a
 30 period of time to exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any single fiscal
 31 year.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 33 ~~2007~~ 2009, through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

34
 35 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8
9 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

17
18 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
