10 FIREWORK PUBLIC DISPLAY PERMITS FROM TWO DAYS TO

14 PERIOD FOR FIREWORK PUBLIC DISPLAY

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-22-702(b), concerning public fireworks  
22 displays, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b)(1) Public displays shall be performed only under competent  
24 supervision and after the persons or organizations making the displays have  
25 applied for and received a permit for the displays issued by the director.

26 (2) Applications for permits for public displays shall be made  
27 in writing at least ~~two (2)~~ five (5) days in advance of the proposed display,  
28 and the application shall show that the proposed display is to be so located  
29 and supervised that it shall not be hazardous to life, limb, or property.

30 (3) If the display is to be performed within the limits of a  
31 municipality, the application shall so state and shall bear the signed  
32 approval of the chief supervisory officials of the fire and police  
33 departments of the municipality.
