10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE NORTHWEST  
11 TECHNICAL INSTITUTE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
12 JUNE 30, 2010; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE NORTHWEST TECHNICAL  
16 INSTITUTE APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
17 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
24 Northwest Technical Institute for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following  
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
33 or its successor.

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28 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Northwest  
 29 Technical Institute for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum  
 30 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 31 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred seven  
 32 (107) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to  
 33 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or  
 34 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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36 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the

1 Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the Northwest Technical  
 2 Institute Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Northwest  
 3 Technical Institute - State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
 4 following:

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SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Northwest Technical Institute, for personal services and operating expenses of the Northwest Technical Institute - Cash for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME FACULTY. The Technical Institutes are not required to remit a state contribution to the state employee insurance trust fund on Workforce Education part-time faculty positions unless the position will be utilized for more than 1,000 hours a year.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL TEACHING LOAD. Instructional staff at Northwest Technical Institute, may be paid up to forty five dollars (\$45) per clock hour for the

1 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010 and up to fifty dollars (\$50) per clock  
2 hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for non-credit teaching  
3 assignments; or up to five hundred dollars (\$500) per semester hour for the  
4 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2008~~ 2010, and up to five hundred fifty dollars  
5 (~~\$550~~) per semester hour for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for  
6 teaching courses beyond the defined teaching load; and the employee's maximum  
7 allowable salary may be exceeded by such amount; provided, however, that such  
8 additional teaching load may not exceed one hundred fifty (150) clock hours  
9 or nine (9) semester credit hours per school year. Further, the provisions  
10 of this section shall only apply to credit and noncredit courses that are  
11 funded by Private Industry.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
13 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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15 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
17 HELP RESTRICTION. No employee at Northwest Technical Institute, who is  
18 employed as "Extra Help" may exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum  
19 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-  
20 5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for  
21 a period of time to exceed fourteen hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal  
22 year.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
24 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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26 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
29 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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36 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
7 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
11 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
