22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the  
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
34 101), or its successor.

17 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - WILLIAM H. BOWEN SCHOOL OF LAW. There is hereby  
 18 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable  
 19 from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, from special revenues  
 20 received from additional uniform filing fees in circuit court as authorized  
 21 by Arkansas Code Annotated 16-10-314, for expenses of the University of  
 22 Arkansas at Little Rock - William H. Bowen School of Law for the fiscal year  
 23 ending June 30, 2010, the following:

30 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
 32 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing  
 33 and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director,  
 34 assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at the  
 35 University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of Trustees may make special  
 36 allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may

1 determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and  
2 exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head  
3 coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of providing such  
4 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary  
5 income of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, which is derived from  
6 athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars  
7 (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each fiscal year ~~of the~~  
8 ~~2007-2009 biennium~~ for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten  
9 thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each  
10 fiscal year ~~the 2007-2009 biennium~~ for the assistant athletic directors and  
11 assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to  
12 the regular salary of such athletic director, assistant athletic directors,  
13 head coaches and assistant coaches, as established herein provided that the  
14 amount of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per  
15 annum for any one salaried position. Further, if the special allowance funds  
16 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas at Little Rock  
17 shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact  
18 disposition of those special allowances funds.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
20 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

22 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
24 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
25 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
26 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
27 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
28 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
29 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
30 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
31 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
32 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or  
33 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief  
34 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the  
35 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal  
36 year.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007  
2 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

4 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
13 with in disbursement of said funds.

14  
15 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
22 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23  
24 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
