9 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT AN OWNER OF A BOAT LIVERY
10 SHALL RECORD THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF A
11 MOTORBOAT; TO REQUIRE A BOAT LIVERY TO NOT ALLOW
12 A VESSEL TO DEPART FROM THE PREMISES WITHOUT THE
13 EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY LAW; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

16 TO CLARIFY THAT AN OWNER OF A BOAT
17 LIVERY SHALL RECORD THE REGISTRATION
18 NUMBER OF A MOTORBOAT; TO REQUIRE AN
19 OWNER OF A BOAT LIVERY TO NOT ALLOW A
20 VESSEL TO DEPART FROM THE PREMISES

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 27-101-204. Duties of boat livery owner.

28 (a) The owner of a boat livery shall cause to be kept a record of:

29 (1) The name and address of the person or persons hiring any
30 vessel ~~which is designed or permitted by him or her to be operated as a~~
31 ~~motorboat;~~

32 (2) The registration number ~~thereof~~ of the vessel if the vessel
33 is designed or permitted to be operated as a motorboat;

34 (3) The departure date and time;

35 (4) The expected time of return; and

(5) The number of persons to be on board the vessel.

(b) The record shall be preserved for at least six (6) months.

(c) Neither the owner of a boat livery nor his or her agent or employee shall permit ~~any motorboat or any~~ a vessel ~~designed~~ owned or permitted by him or her ~~to be operated as a motorboat~~ to depart from his or her premises unless ~~it shall have been~~ the boat livery has provided, either by owner or renter, with the vessel with the equipment required ~~pursuant to~~ under § 27-101-203(a) and any rules ~~and regulations~~ made ~~pursuant thereto~~ under that section.
