22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
25 the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

24 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
 26 ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees, after seeking prior review by the
 27 Arkansas Legislative Council, may approve the employment of competent
 28 scientists with extraordinary research capabilities to conduct research in
 29 the Biomedical Research Center established at the University of Arkansas at
 30 Pine Bluff. Further, that the Board of Trustees of the University of
 31 Arkansas be authorized to approve salaries for scientists up to, but not to
 32 exceed, one and one-half of that portion of the Distinguished Professor line
 33 item maximum authorized by the General Assembly to be paid from University of
 34 Arkansas at Pine Bluff funds.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 36 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

2 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. JENKINS
4 CENTER. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the sum of \$252,558 ~~is~~ for
5 the ~~2007-2008~~ fiscal year and ~~\$252,558 in the 2008-2009 fiscal year~~ shall be
6 used to provide support to the Jenkins Center in Pine Bluff. Provided,
7 however, such funds shall be used to conduct and maintain a University
8 training program in cooperation with the Jenkins Center. Provided, further,
9 any reductions in funding for appropriation provided in Section 3 shall be
10 proportionately applied to the funds set out herein for support.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

16 COMPUTATIONS – 1890 MATCHING FUNDS. Any computations made by the Department
17 of Higher Education and the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board in
18 determining levels of recommended funding for the University of Arkansas at
19 Pine Bluff shall include matching funds for the 1890 Research and Extension
20 Programs in the base.

22 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
24 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
25 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
26 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
27 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
28 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
29 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
30 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
31 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
32 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or
33 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief
34 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the
35 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal
36 year.
