21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
24 the Ouachita Technical College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following  
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
33 or its successor.

21 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 22 Ouachita Technical College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following  
 23 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 24 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: sixty (60)  
 25 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed  
 26 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
 27 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

29 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 30 to the Ouachita Technical College, to be payable from the Ouachita Technical  
 31 College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Ouachita  
 32 Technical College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 11 the Ouachita Technical College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
 12 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Ouachita Technical College, for personal  
 13 services and operating expenses of the Ouachita Technical College for the  
 14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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30 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

32 PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Ouachita Technical College shall be to  
 33 combat illiteracy and to provide industrial training in the work place.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
 35 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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1 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
3 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
4 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
5 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
6 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
7 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
8 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
9 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
10 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
11 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon  
12 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal  
13 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board  
14 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.  
15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~  
16 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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18 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
21 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
24 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
25 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
26 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
27 with in disbursement of said funds.

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29 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
36 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
