21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Office of the Governor for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

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33 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
34 Office of the Governor for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum
35 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
36 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: seven (7)

1 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 2 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 3 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

 5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 6 the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services
 7 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the
 8 Governor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

 23 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 24 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 25 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 26 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Agency is
 27 authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in Section
 28 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Governor's Office in this Act to any
 29 other line item authorized in Section 3.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
 31 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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 33 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES.
 35 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and
 36 retained, the Office of the Governor may exceed the maximum salary levels by

1 no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the
2 positions authorized in the ~~biennial~~ operation appropriation act after
3 receiving approval from the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
4 Committee.

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6 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15
16 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
