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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Division
26 of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee for the
27 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees, the
28 grades to be assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum annual
29 salaries for each such position. The maximum annual salary for the position
30 assigned to grades shall be determined in accordance with, but shall not
31 exceed the maximum annual amount for the grade assigned herein, as
32 established in Arkansas Code 21-5-209. Except for the purpose of determining
33 the maximum annual salary rate, which is to be applicable to each of the
34 positions to which a salary grade is assigned hereinafter, in accordance with
35 the provisions of Arkansas Code 21-5-209, all positions set forth herein



1 shall be exempt from other provisions of the Uniform Classification and
 2 Compensation Act, or its successor, but shall not be exempt from the
 3 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its
 4 successor.

15 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Division of
 16 Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, to be payable
 17 from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Division
 18 of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee for the
 19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

27 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDS.
 29 In the event the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint
 30 Auditing Committee should receive any funds in connection with performing
 31 their duties as prescribed by the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, such
 32 funds shall be deposited into the State Central Services Fund to be utilized
 33 solely by the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing
 34 Committee in performing such duties.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009
 36 through June 30, 2010.

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SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
