11 *FROM EXPOSURE TO TOXIC CHEMICALS; TO AUTHORIZE*

13 *SCRAP METAL A MOTOR VEHICLE IN WHICH*  
14 *METHAMPHETAMINE HAS BEEN MANUFACTURED; AND FOR*

18 *TO PROTECT CONSUMERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES*  
19 *FROM EXPOSURE TO TOXIC CHEMICALS; TO*  
20 *AUTHORIZE PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS TO*  
21 *DESTROY OR SELL FOR SCRAP METAL A MOTOR*

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 64, Subchapter 5 is amended*  
28 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

29 *5-64-510. Methamphetamine-contaminated motor vehicles.*

30 *(a) As used in this section, "methamphetamine-contaminated motor*  
31 *vehicle" means a motor vehicle that has been forfeited under § 5-64-505 in*  
32 *which methamphetamine was manufactured as determined by a law enforcement*  
33 *agency or a prosecuting attorney who has possession of the motor vehicle.*

34 *(b) A law enforcement agency or a prosecuting attorney who has*  
35 *possession of a methamphetamine-contaminated motor vehicle shall destroy or*



1 sell for scrap metal the methamphetamine-contaminated motor vehicle.
