24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CONTINUING EDUCATION - COUNTY CLERKS. There is
27 hereby appropriated, to the Auditor of State, to be payable from the County
28 and Circuit Clerks Continuing Education Fund, for the County Clerks'
29 Continuing Education Board in carrying out the responsibilities for
30 maintaining and operating a continuing education program and certification
31 program for county clerks by the County Clerks' Continuing Education Board
32 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

 10 program for circuit clerks by the Circuit Clerks' Continuing Education Board

 24 treasurers by the County Treasurers' Continuing Education Board for the

 32 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CONTINUING EDUCATION - COUNTY COLLECTORS. There
 33 is hereby appropriated, to the Auditor of State, to be payable from the
 34 County Collector's Continuing Education Trust Fund, for the County
 35 Collectors' Continuing Education Board in carrying out their responsibilities
 36 for maintaining and operating a continuing education program and

1 certification program for county collectors by the County Collectors'
2 Continuing Education Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
3 following:

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11 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
14 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29
30 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the

1 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
2 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
