21 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 23 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - GRANTS TO COMMUNITY BASED PROVIDERS. Funds
 24 allocated under the appropriation for community-based services, for Grants to
 25 Community Providers, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-
 26 Aid appropriation in this act shall be used only to provide services through
 27 private community based services licensed or certified by the Arkansas
 28 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS). Non-profit community-
 29 based programs licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
 30 Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities of the state which provide
 31 supports and services to individuals who have a developmental disability or
 32 delay, who would otherwise require supports and services through state-
 33 operated programs and facilities owned by the State of Arkansas. When DDS
 34 licensed providers are involved in delivering services which are Medicaid
 35 reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas Medicaid
 36 Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered services

1 for eligible individuals.

2 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program or
3 under the Alternative Community Services Waiver Program (ACS) will be
4 utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible
5 for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a
6 general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for
7 appropriate services.

8 The State shall require each provider funded from this Appropriation for
9 community based services, including funding from the Grants/Patient Services
10 Line, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Operations appropriation,
11 or from the Grants to Community Providers Line, in the Developmental
12 Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation, to screen each
13 individual to whom services are provided for a determination of eligibility
14 or ineligibility for Medicaid coverage within thirty days of the first date
15 that services are provided. It is the intent of this section to insure that
16 wherever possible and appropriate, Medicaid funds are utilized for covered or
17 waived services to individuals who are eligible for coverage under the
18 Arkansas Medicaid Program or the ACS Waiver.

19 Nothing in this Act shall prevent the Division or any provider from
20 extending emergency services when appropriate measures have been taken in a
21 timely manner to secure Medicaid eligibility.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
23 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

25 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

27 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - VOCATIONAL TRAINEES. The Division of
28 Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services is
29 hereby authorized to provide employment opportunities for people with
30 developmental disabilities residing at the Human Development Centers who work
31 less than a competitive employment level.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
33 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

35 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS IN

1 AID - CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING FUNDS. Private non-profit community-based
2 programs licensed by the Department of Human Services, Developmental
3 Disabilities Services, are eligible to receive funds appropriated for Grants
4 to Community Providers in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-
5 in-Aid appropriation of this Act, and as a condition of receiving such funds
6 they shall:

7 1. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to
8 people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Human Services,
9 Developmental Disabilities Services.

10 2. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Human
11 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.

12 3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
13 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.

14 4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
15 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
16 individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community
17 support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who
18 reside within the respective area of the program.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
20 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

22 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

24 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES – TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
25 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
26 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
27 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
28 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental
29 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
30 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
31 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
32 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
33 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
34 major capital equipment.

35 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
36 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

1 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the
2 harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the
3 Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds
4 derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant
5 state purchasing laws.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~
7 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

9 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
11 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.

12 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
13 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
14 Development Centers ~~that provide therapy and residential services, which are~~
15 located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro, Booneville, and Warren.

16 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients
17 for whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed
18 at state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs
19 licensed by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been
20 determined in accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the
21 community.

22 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community
23 based services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
24 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-
25 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly ~~benefits~~ benefit(s)
26 community based services for persons with developmental disabilities or from
27 the appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
28 directly ~~benefits~~ benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.

29 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of ~~March 1, 2007~~ July 1,
30 2011 from the Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental
31 Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with
32 developmental disabilities or from any other general revenues as of ~~March 1,~~
33 ~~2007~~ July 1, 2011, applied as federal matching funds for community based
34 services licensed by DDS on ~~March 1, 2007~~ July 1, 2011 be reduced below the
35 approved funding level on ~~March 1, 2007~~ July 1, 2011; nor shall the general
36 revenues applied as federal matching funds for the Human Development Centers

1 be reduced below the approved funding level on ~~March 1, 2007~~ July 1, 2011.

2
3 *SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE*
4 *ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.*
5 *AUTISM TREATMENT AND COORDINATION. The Department of Human Services -*
6 *Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall promulgate rules and*
7 *regulations regarding the licensure and oversight of Applied Behavior*
8 *Analysts as described in Arkansas Code § 23-99-418. The rules and regulations*
9 *shall include a requirement for a licensure application fee equal to that*
10 *charged to applicants to be licensed as a psychologist as described in*
11 *Arkansas Code § 17-97-309. Proceeds from this fee are declared as cash funds.*
12

13 *SECTION 18. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.* Disbursement of funds
14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
22

23 *SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
31

32 *SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the*
33 *General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits*
34 *the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the*
35 *effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of*
36 *the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in*

1 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
3 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
