22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*  
25 *Arkansas Science and Technology Authority - Office of Health Information*  
26 *Technology for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number of*  
27 *regular employees.*

10 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY -

11 FEDERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Science

12 and Technology Authority, to be payable from the federal funds as designated

13 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating

14 expenses of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority - Office of Health

15 Information Technology - Federal Operations for the fiscal year ending June

16 30, 2012, the following:

31 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY -

32 HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the

33 Arkansas Science and Technology Authority, to be payable from the Health

34 Information Technology Fund, for personal services, state match, operating

35 expenses and program matching grants by the Arkansas Science and Technology

36 Authority - Office of Health Information Technology for the fiscal year

1 ending June 30, 2012, the following:

10 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
 12 TRANSFER PROVISION. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011,  
 13 any unexpended balance of funds remaining in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund  
 14 Account for the DFA-Health Information Exchange Program shall be transferred  
 15 to the Health Information Technology Fund to provide state match for the  
 16 Federal – Health Information Technology Program.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
 18 2011 through June 30, 2012.

19

20 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

29

30 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of  
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
8 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
9 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm  
10 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
11 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
12 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
13 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
