2	(a) It is in the best interest of the people of the State of Arkansas		
3	to have a water policy that recognizes the vital importance of water to the		
4	prosperity and health of both people and their natural surroundings.		
5	(b) Preserving water of a sufficient quality and quantity will allow		
6	Arkansas to be known both as a natural state and a land of opportunity where		
7	agriculture, industry, tourism, and recreation will remain strong for future		
8	generations.		
9	(c) It is declared to be the policy of the State of Arkansas to		
10	encourage best management practices and reliable data to provide scientific		
11	methods for managing and conserving water for future use in recognition of		
12	the facts that:		
13	(1) Arkansas has annual rainfall providing surplus surface water		
14	for the use of persons in this state, while continuing to provide water for		
15	wildlife habitat, recreation, industry, agriculture, and commerce;		
16	(2) In many instances much of this surplus water is now		
17	underutilized;		
18	(3) The groundwater supplies of the state are being used at a		
19	rate that will result in valuable water aquifers being destroyed, harming		
20	both the general public and the private property rights of those owning		
21	property in this state; and		
22	(4) Surface water and ground water supplies must be managed

24	(d) It is declared to be the purpose of this subchapter to permit and		
25	regulate the construction of facilities to use surplus surface water in order

27	(1) Protect critical groundwater supplies that are a significant		
28	source of the drinking water supply for thousands of people in Arkansas;		
29	(2) Protect the rights of all persons equitably and reasonably		
30	interested in the use and disposition of water;		
31	(3) Maintain healthy in-stream flows for all streams and rivers;
