8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
15 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE BALANCES GENERAL IMPROVEMENT -
23 84TH SESSION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
24 Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General
25 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department
26 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 258 of 2010, for disbursing the balance of funds
29 which were made available by law to the projects in Section 3(b) of the
30 General Improvement Distribution Act of 2003, in a sum not to exceed
31\$603,765.
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33 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE BALANCES GENERAL IMPROVEMENT -
34 85TH SESSION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
35 Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General
36 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department



1 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 258 of 2010, for disbursing the balance of funds
4 which were made available by law to the projects in Section 3(b) of the
5 General Improvement Distribution Act of 2005, in a sum not to exceed
6\$627,326.

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8 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS. There is
9 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
10 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
11 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
12 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 258 of 2010, for grants to fire departments, in
15 a sum not to exceed.....\$109,897.

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17 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION. There is
18 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
19 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
20 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
21 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

22 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 258 of 2010, for one-time replacement, over a
24 two-year period, of state vehicles, in a sum not to exceed.....\$86,067.

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26 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - COUNTY HOSPITALS. There is hereby
27 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
28 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
29 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -
30 Disbursing Officer the following:

31 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (A) Section 17 of Act 258 of 2010, for a grant to the Department of
33 Human Services, for repairs, technology, training, infrastructure needs and
34 expenses for county hospitals, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000.

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36 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - RIVER TRAIL SYSTEM. There is hereby

1 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
2 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
3 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -
4 Disbursing Officer the following:

5 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (A) Section 15 of Act 258 of 2010, for a grant for construction,
7 renovation and improvements for a River Trail System, in a sum not to exceed
8\$125,000.

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10 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - MAJOR MAINTENANCE. There is hereby
11 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
12 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
13 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -
14 Disbursing Officer the following:

15 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 258 of 2010, for major maintenance, renovation,
17 repair or construction to provide contingency appropriation for capital
18 projects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

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20 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
22 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
23 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
24 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 258 of 2010, for State Motor Vehicle
27 Acquisition, in a sum not to exceed.....\$12,000,000.

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29 SECTION 9. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
30 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
31 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
32 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
33 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
34 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
35 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
36 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects

1 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
2 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
3 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
4 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

5 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
6 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
7 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
8 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
9 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
10 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
11 otherwise by law.

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13 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that previous
25 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or
26 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the
27 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,
28 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the
29 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.
30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
31 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
