8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 ARKANSAS STATE POLICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE
14 POLICE REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be payable from
22 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Department of Arkansas State Police the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for grants to Police Departments
26 for communication capabilities enhancements and equipment upgrades, including
27 the implementation of a Trunking Radio System, in a sum not to exceed
28\$75,000.

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for various maintenance,
31 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
32 repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities, in a sum
33 not to exceed.....\$500,000.

34 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for capital outlay, purchase of
36 equipment, and expenses for the Arkansas State Police Fleet Rotation Plan, in



1 a sum not to exceed.....\$4,000,000.

2 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for construction, repair, and
4 related expenses for the Arkansas Wireless Information Network (AWIN)
5 Building/Tower Replacement, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,002.

6 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for the purchase, installation,
8 integration, and related expenses for the Arkansas Wireless Information
9 Network (AWIN) Zone Controller, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,100,000.

10 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for constructing and equipping the
12 Winthrop Paul Rockefeller Arkansas State Police Hall of Honor, in a sum not
13 to exceed.....\$49,667.

14 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for constructing and equipping the
16 Winthrop Paul Rockefeller Arkansas State Police Hall of Honor, in a sum not
17 to exceed.....\$4,815.

18 (H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for constructing and equipping the
20 Winthrop Paul Rockefeller Arkansas State Police Hall of Honor, in a sum not
21 to exceed.....\$72,881.

22 (I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for constructing and equipping the
24 Winthrop Paul Rockefeller Arkansas State Police Hall of Honor, in a sum not
25 to exceed.....\$74,408.

26 (J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for grants and aid for drug task
28 force operations and related programs, in a sum not to exceed.....\$75,000.

29 (K) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (K) Section 1 of Act 189 of 2010, for construction of various Highway
31 Patrol Troop Headquarters including Troop K - Hot Springs, Troop L -
32 Springdale, and Troop F - CID Company B - Warren, in a sum not to exceed
33\$4,417.
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35 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
36 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

1 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 2 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 3 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 4 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 5 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 6 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 7 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 8 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 9 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
 10 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

11 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
 12 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
 13 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
 14 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
 15 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
 16 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
 17 otherwise by law.

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 19 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 28 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 30 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
 35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
2 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
