Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND
15 TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATION FOR
16 THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department for the 2012-2013 fiscal
24 year, the following maximum number of regular employees and the maximum
25 annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that established
26 herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations hereinafter made for
27 said department. The annual salaries to be paid to each employee authorized
28 herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway Commission within the
29 limitations as set out in this Section and the funds and the appropriations
30 made available for such purposes. All positions established herein shall be
31 exempt from the provisions of the Uniform Personnel Classification and
32 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, but
33 shall not be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures
34 and Restrictions Act. Provided further that the salaries for the pay period
35 beginning June 28, 2012 can be paid from the salaries and overtime authorized
36 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013.

5 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
7 The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its
8 employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the
9 policies established by the Commission. The executives and administrators of
10 the Department shall be exempt from overtime payments as will certain
11 professional employees occupying positions specifically exempt under the
12 overtime policies established by the Commission.
13 For the purpose of paying overtime, any portion of Item 3 (Overtime) of
14 Section 2 may be transferred to and be combined with Item 1 (Salaries) in

11 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20
21 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29
30 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
31 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
32 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm

1 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
2 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
3 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
4 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
