20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ATTORNEY FEES. The disbursing officer of the appropriations provided for herein, shall deposit all monies received by the Office of Attorney General as attorney fees in the State Central Services Fund as direct revenues.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~ 2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2013.

SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Office of Attorney General is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Office of Attorney General in this Act to any other line item authorized in Section 3.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2010~~ 2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2013.

*SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. QUARTERLY  
2 REPORTS. The Office of Attorney General shall on a quarterly basis provide to  
3 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee a report of all  
4 cash funds received from court orders or settlement agreements. The report  
5 shall include:

6 a) The case name of the court order or settlement agreement.

7 b) The amount of funds received by the Office of Attorney General for each  
8 court order or settlement agreement.

9 c) A plan for disbursement of the funds. If cash funds received from a  
10 court order or settlement agreement are expended for any purpose, including  
11 consumer education and enforcement activities, the report must itemize  
12 specific activities subject to the exclusions provided in Ark. Code Ann. 4-  
13 88-111 and 25-1-403(1)(B). The report shall also itemize the specific  
14 consumer education and enforcement activities funded for the Office of  
15 Attorney General.

16 d) If funds received from court order or settlement agreement are given to  
17 a specific entity by the Office of Attorney General the report must include:

18 1) If the court order or settlement agreement directed monies to  
19 be given to a specific entity and;

20 2) If the court order or settlement agreement directs funds to a  
21 specific entity, the Office of the Attorney General shall provide a summary  
22 of input regarding the drafting of the court order or settlement agreement.

23 e) If the Office of Attorney General receives funds from a court order or  
24 settlement agreement that does not require disbursement of funds to a  
25 specific entity, the Office of Attorney General shall report a rationale for  
26 disbursing funds to a specific entity.

27 f) A report of current balances of all unappropriated cash fund holdings  
28 received by court order or settlement agreement by the Office of Attorney  
29 General.

30 g) The quarterly reports shall be provided no later than the 15th day of  
31 the month immediately following the end of each quarter.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
33 2012 through June 30, 2013.

34  
35 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8  
9 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

17  
18 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of  
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
24 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm  
25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
28 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
