8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 EDUCATION - AND ITS VARIOUS DIVISIONS; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
15 AND ITS VARIOUS DIVISIONS
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - GENERAL
23 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education,
24 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
25 accounts, for the Department of Education the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 7 of 2012, for grants to eligible public schools
28 for school recognition awards to be used for nonrecurring bonuses to faculty
29 and staff, nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials
30 or temporary school personnel by the Arkansas School Recognition Program, in
31 a sum not to exceed.....\$28,383.

32 (B) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 7 of 2012, for grants for construction,
34 improvements, equipment, maintenance and operating costs for community
35 organizations where schools are in jeopardy of being closed or consolidated,
36 in a sum not to exceed.....\$60,000.



1 (C) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 7 of 2012, for grants for after-school,
3 literacy, and nutrition services for at-risk children and youth, in a sum not
4 to exceed.....\$31,250.

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6 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIC
7 FACILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION - SCHOOL BUS SAFETY. There is hereby
8 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Division of Public School
9 Academic Facilities and Transportation, to be payable from the General
10 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department
11 of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
12 Transportation the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 7 of 2012, for personal services, operating
15 expenses, and purchase of equipment for a School Bus Safety Equipment Grant
16 Pilot Program, in a sum not to exceed.....\$35,934.

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18 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - GENERAL
19 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
20 Arkansas School for the Blind, to be payable from the General Improvement
21 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education
22 - Arkansas School for the Blind the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 7 of 2012, for various maintenance, renovation,
25 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of
26 real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

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28 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.
29 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas
30 School for the Deaf, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
31 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education - Arkansas
32 School for the Deaf the following:

33 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 7 of 2012, for replacement of the existing
35 electrical system at the Arkansas School for the Deaf, in a sum not to exceed
36\$557,524.

1 (B) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (B) Section 6 of Act 7 of 2012, for various maintenance, renovation,
3 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of
4 real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

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6 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - FEDERAL FUNDS.

7 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas
8 School for the Deaf, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by
9 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Education -
10 Arkansas School for the Deaf the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 7 of 2012, for replacement of the existing
13 electrical system at the Arkansas School for the Deaf, in a sum not to exceed
14\$823,200.

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16 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION - GENERAL
17 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
18 Educational Television Division, to be payable from the General Improvement
19 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education
20 - Educational Television Division the following:

21 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (E) Section 9 of Act 7 of 2012, for various maintenance, renovation,
23 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of
24 real property and facilities, including grant matching, in a sum not to
25 exceed.....\$1,000,000.

26 (B) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (F) Section 9 of Act 7 of 2012, for a transfer to the Educational
28 Television Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses for the
29 "Honoring Arkansas' War Heroes - Documenting Stories of Arkansas' World War
30 II Veterans" documentation project of the Department of Education -
31 Educational Television Division, in a sum not to exceed.....\$260,000.

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33 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION - FEDERAL
34 FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
35 Educational Television Division, to be payable from the federal funds as
36 designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of

1 Education - Educational Television Division the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (A) Section 8 of Act 7 of 2012, for costs associated with General
4 Network Maintenance needed to secure the state's investment in technology, in
5 a sum not to exceed.....\$76,802.

6 (B) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (B) Section 8 of Act 7 of 2012, for preventive and major maintenance,
8 routine and emergency equipment repairs, and equipment replacement, in a sum
9 not to exceed.....\$40,122.

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11 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION - GENERAL
12 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
13 Educational Television Division, to be payable from the General Improvement
14 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education
15 - Educational Television Division the following:

16 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (A) Section 9 of Act 7 of 2012, for costs associated with the
18 planning for a Northwest Communications Center and implementing, equipping,
19 maintenance and operating expenses of an AETN satellite broadcasting site in
20 Northwest Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$99,904.

21 (B) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (B) Section 9 of Act 7 of 2012, for costs associated with
23 implementing an AETN satellite broadcasting site in Northwest Arkansas and
24 for use by the University of Arkansas and AETN, in a sum not to exceed
25\$89,191.

26 (C) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (C) Section 9 of Act 7 of 2012, for costs associated with general
28 network maintenance needed to secure the state's investment in technology and
29 to provide state matching for federal grants, in a sum not to exceed
30\$283,514.

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32 SECTION 9. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
33 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
34 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
35 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
36 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

1 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
2 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
3 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
4 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
5 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
6 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
7 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

8 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
9 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
10 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
11 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
12 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
13 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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15 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
25 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
26 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
