8 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE EIGHTY-NINTH SESSION PROJECTS  
9 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND; TO  
10 DEFINE THE MONIES TO BE AVAILABLE IN SUCH ACCOUNT;  
11 AND TO DEFINE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH MONIES MAY BE  
12 MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND SO  
13 THAT ADDITIONAL FUNDS CAN BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE  
14 STATE BUDGET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 **Subtitle**

18 THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH  
19 SESSION PROJECTS ACCOUNT OF THE GENERAL  
20 IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL  
21 FUNDS FOR THE STATE BUDGET.  
22

23  
24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "General Improvement  
27 Distribution Act of 2013".  
28

29 SECTION 2. There is hereby created and established on the books of the  
30 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Treasurer and the State Auditor,  
31 the "89th Session Projects Account" within the "General Improvement Fund",  
32 into which shall be transferred and credited the respective monies as  
33 hereinafter provided in this Act, to be used for providing financing, in the  
34 manner set forth herein, for the various projects and purposes enumerated in  
35 this Act to be financed from said account.

36 Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, or as soon thereafter as is



1 practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "89th Session  
2 Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon certification of  
3 the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the following:

4 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General  
5 Improvement Fund" on June 30, 2013 which are not required to finance projects  
6 to be financed there from pursuant to appropriations enacted by the 88th  
7 General Assembly, or which have not been reappropriated or reallocated for  
8 financing from the "General Improvement Fund" by the 89th General Assembly;

9 (b) any unobligated or unallocated funds remaining on July 2, 2013,  
10 including all General Revenue Funds recovered from remaining fund balances in  
11 the "General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund" from monies accruing thereto  
12 during the 2011-2013 fiscal biennium which are not required to finance  
13 enactments of the 89th General Assembly that do not expire on June 30, 2013;

14 (c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in  
15 this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 2013, and ending June  
16 30, 2015, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

17 (1) Arkansas Code 27-70-204 for distributing interest income  
18 earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and  
19 Transportation Department Fund",

20 (2) Arkansas Code 15-41-110 for distributing interest earned from  
21 investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund", and

22 (3) Arkansas Code 20-78-504 for the next one hundred thousand  
23 dollars (\$100,000) of interest income received each fiscal year by the State  
24 Treasurer for the "Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guarantee Trust Fund",  
25 credit to the "Budget Stabilization Trust Fund" or its successor fund, fifty  
26 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities  
27 Reserve Fund", and credit to the "89th Session Projects Account" fifty  
28 percent (50%) of the interest income received and credited to the "Securities  
29 Reserve Fund" as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to  
30 provide financing to the "89th Session Projects Account", until there has  
31 been credited an amount, which when added to the other funds available for  
32 such purposes will finance each of the projects or purposes hereinafter  
33 enumerated;

34 (d) Those special revenues credited to the General Improvement  
35 *Fund from estate taxes as set out in Arkansas Code 19-6-301(171);*

36 (e) Any available balance remaining in the 88th Session Projects

1 Account of the General Improvement Fund from funds set aside in (a)(1) and  
2 (a)(2) of Section 3 of Act 1096 and Act 1117 of 2011, and Section 17 of Act  
3 1095 and Act 1115 of 2011 to be made available and distributed as authorized  
4 in Section 3(a)(2) herein.

5  
6 SECTION 3. Of those moneys accruing to the 89th Session Projects Account  
7 of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act, the  
8 State Treasurer shall first set-aside one hundred eighty one million four  
9 hundred eighty five thousand five hundred and fifty one dollars  
10 (\$181,485,551), and any previous set aside remaining balance as made  
11 available by Section 2(e), so much as may be available in the set side in  
12 authorized in Section 3(b) of this Act, and a protected set aside amount not  
13 to exceed fifteen million nine hundred eighty three thousand two hundred and  
14 twenty four dollars (\$15,983,224) as set aside in (a)(7). Such funds set-  
15 aside as enumerated in subsection (a)(1) through (a)(26) shall be fully  
16 funded by June 30, 2015. Funds made available for (a)(1), (a)(2) and (d) may  
17 be released in full or in portion thereof as enumerated, but shall not exceed  
18 the maximum amount set out for the project. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
19 State shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget  
20 Committee of the release of funds for projects enumerated in subsection (a)  
21 and (d) at the same time that the Department of Finance and Administration is  
22 notified.

15 Improvement Fund which shall be transferred to the Medicaid Expansion Program  
16 Account of the Tobacco Settlement Program Fund in the event and in the amount  
17 that funds are not received by the State as authorized by the transfer  
18 through the settlement agreement in the nearly decade old dispute between  
19 Arkansas and the tobacco companies that signed the Master Settlement  
20 Agreement as authorized in the Fund Transfer Provision - Medicaid Program in  
21 Section 20 of HB1219 of 2013 as enacted by the 89th General Assembly.

22 (B) Further, if funds or a portion of the funds are received and  
23 transferred as authorized in the Fund Transfer Provision - Medicaid Program  
24 in Section 20 of HB1219 of 2013 as enacted by the 89th General Assembly any  
25 remaining funds in the protected set aside not distributed in (a)7(A) shall  
26 be distributed as authorized in Section 3(b) herein. If Section 3(b) is  
27 fully funded any remaining funds shall be transferred to and remain in the  
28 unobligated balances of the General Improvement Fund until otherwise  
29 authorized by the General Assembly;

10 (b) Then the Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations on  
11 the basis of fifty nine and three tenths percent (59.30%) of the total  
12 available funds to the Executive Discretionary Division as set out in  
13 subsection (d) and the remainder of the total available funds to the  
14 Legislative Division listed in subsection (c). The Legislative Division  
15 funds shall be used to provide funds to each project enumerated in subsection  
16 (c) of this section in proportion that each project's allocation bears to the  
17 total of the allocations of all projects enumerated in subsection (c).  
18 Additional funds that may be received by the General Improvement Fund after  
19 the projects in subsection (c) have been fully funded shall first be  
20 transferred in an amount not to exceed ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to  
21 the set aside authorized in Section 3(a)(2) herein. Then any additional  
22 funds shall remain in the General Improvement Fund for such purpose as may be  
23 enacted by law, but shall not be a part of the 89th Session Projects Account.

24 Funds made available to the Executive Discretionary Division may be  
25 used for any project or portion thereof enumerated within the Executive  
26 Discretionary Division but not to exceed the amount set out in subsection (d)  
27 for the project. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the  
28 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee of the Governor's  
29 released funds for projects at the same time that the Department of Finance  
30 and Administration is notified.

31

28        SECTION 4. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
 29        SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXECUTIVE DIVISION FUNDING  
 30        TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal  
 31        Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the  
 32        State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State any remaining unobligated funds  
 33        from the Executive Division of the 88th Session Projects Account of the  
 34        General Improvement Fund in subsection (d) of Section 3 of Acts 1096 and 1117  
 35        of 2011 to provide funding in addition to that set out in subsection (b) of  
 36        Section 3 of this Act, for the 89th Session Projects Account of the General

1 Improvement Fund for the Executive Division as set out in subsection (d) of  
2 Section 3 herein.

3  
4 SECTION 5. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
5 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER STATE LAND  
6 DEPARTMENT. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, or as soon  
7 thereafter as is practicable, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall  
8 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of  
9 State the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the cash funds of the  
10 State Land Department to the 89th Session Projects Account of the General  
11 Improvement Fund.

12  
13 SECTION 6. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
14 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately  
15 upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State  
16 shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and  
17 Auditor of State the sum of ten million four hundred eighty eight dollars  
18 three hundred and seventy nine dollars (\$10,488,379) from the Red River  
19 Waterways Project Trust Fund to the 89th Session Projects Account of the  
20 General Improvement Fund.

21  
22 SECTION 7. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
23 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENATE AND HOUSE BILL  
24 REFERENCES. All Senate and House bills referenced in this Act are effective  
25 as enacted by the 89th General Assembly in the 2013 Regular Session.

26  
27 SECTION 8. DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS. (a) Expenditure of the funds  
28 authorized by the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly in either the regular, fiscal  
29 or extraordinary session from the 89th Session Projects Account shall be made  
30 only upon documentation to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, in such  
31 form as deemed necessary, that all criteria or pre-conditions established in  
32 the appropriation act have been met or in the case of state agencies, and  
33 that a Method of Finance has been filed with the Office of Accounting in the  
34 Department of Finance and Administration, if required.

35 (b) Any matching funds as may be provided in law shall be certified to the  
36 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State prior to the commencement of the project.

1 (c) Any recipient of the funds appropriated herein:

2 (1) may be required to file a compliance audit and

3 (2) is also subject to an audit by the Division of Legislative Audit in  
4 order to determine that the use of the funds was in compliance with the  
5 intent and appropriated purposes of the General Assembly.

6

7 SECTION 9. (a) Any enactment of the 89th General Assembly in either  
8 regular, fiscal or extraordinary session appropriating, transferring or  
9 allocating funds to be payable from the "General Improvement Fund", for which  
10 a specific allocation of funds is specifically authorized in this Act, shall  
11 be deemed to be payable from the "89th Session Projects Account" within the  
12 "General Improvement Fund" unless a specific intent is otherwise provided by  
13 law.

14 (b) Any enactment of the 89th General Assembly, meeting in either Regular,  
15 Fiscal or Extraordinary Session, appropriating, allocating or transferring  
16 funds payable from the General Improvement Fund which is not enumerated in  
17 this Act shall not be financed from monies accruing to the 89th Session  
18 Projects Account, unless otherwise provided by law and funds are specifically  
19 transferred from the 88th Session Projects Account to the 89th Session  
20 Projects Account to fund the appropriation for the project

21 (c) Monies reappropriated by the 89th General Assembly for projects for  
22 which appropriations were made by the 88th General Assembly, which are not  
23 enumerated in this Act and which are made payable from the "General  
24 Improvement Fund", shall be payable from the "88th Session Projects Account"  
25 of the "General Improvement Fund" and allowances shall be made therefore in  
26 arriving at the uncommitted and unobligated balance of monies in the "General  
27 Improvement Fund" before making transfers there from to the "89th Session  
28 Projects Account", as authorized by this Act.

29

30 SECTION 10. Distribution of funds for constructing and equipping the  
31 radiation therapy institutes specified herein, shall be contingent upon the  
32 provision of matching funds, including those monies previously raised but not  
33 previously used to match state funds, on a dollar by dollar basis on behalf  
34 of each such radiation therapy institute.

35

36 SECTION 11. Department of Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer.

1 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may distribute funds to the projects in  
2 the Legislative Division enumerated under Department of Finance and  
3 Administration - Disbursing Officer on a basis other than monthly after prior  
4 review of the proposed calendar for disbursements by the Legislative Council.  
5

6 SECTION 12. This Act shall not be incorporated into the Arkansas Code  
7 nor published separately as Special, Local and Temporary law.  
8

9 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
10 Assembly that it has considered and enacted appropriations for construction  
11 projects and other programs to be financed from the accumulated balances and  
12 reserve funds available in the State Treasury; that the total of the enacted  
13 appropriations exceed the estimated available funding available for such  
14 projects and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to establish  
15 a method of providing for the orderly financing and a system of priority for  
16 the financing of such projects. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist  
17 and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
18 peace, health and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
