9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
15 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS. There is
23 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
24 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
25 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
26 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 68 of 2012, for grants to fire departments, in a
29 sum not to exceed.....\$40,734.
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31 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - COUNTY HOSPITALS. There is hereby
32 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
33 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
34 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -
35 Disbursing Officer the following:

36 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 68 of 2012, for a grant to the Department of
2 Human Services, for repairs, technology, training, infrastructure needs and
3 expenses for county hospitals, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000.
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5 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION. There is
6 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
7 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
8 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
9 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

10 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 68 of 2012, for State Motor Vehicle Acquisition,
12 in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,394,506.
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14 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - LIGNITE DRILLING, TESTING AND REPORTING.
15 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
16 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
17 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
18 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

19 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 68 of 2012, for a grant to the Arkansas
21 Geological Survey for professional services, maintenance, general operating
22 expenses, and matching funds for drilling and testing lignite core samples
23 and reporting of the findings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,500,000.
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25 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - MULTIYEAR REGISTRATION PILOT PROGRAM.
26 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
27 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
28 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
29 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

30 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 68 of 2012, for computer maintenance and
32 operations, upgrades, software, hardware and for custom programming changes
33 and charges associated with the Multiyear Registration Pilot Program, in a
34 sum not to exceed.....\$100,000.
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36 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to

1 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be
 2 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
 3 accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
 4 Officer the following:

5 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
 6 in Item (A) Section 10 of Act 68 of 2012, for a grant to the Game and Fish
 7 Commission, for grants for personal services and operating expenses,
 8 construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance expenses
 9 for Hunters Feeding the Hungry, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.

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 11 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - MAJOR MAINTENANCE. There is hereby
 12 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
 13 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
 14 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -
 15 Disbursing Officer the following:

16 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
 17 in Item (A) Section 11 of Act 68 of 2012, for major maintenance, renovation,
 18 repair or construction to provide contingency appropriation for capital
 19 projects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$440,000.

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 21 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - STATE MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION. There is
 22 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
 23 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
 24 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
 25 Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
 27 in Item (A) Section 12 of Act 68 of 2012, for State Motor Vehicle
 28 Acquisition, in a sum not to exceed.....\$11,000,000.

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 30 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION GRANTS AND
 31 ASSISTANCE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
 32 Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General
 33 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department
 34 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2013, the balance of the appropriation provided
 36 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 69 of 2012, for a grant to the Department of

1 Human Services - Division of Administrative Services, for grants and
 2 assistance to community organizations for maintenance and general operations,
 3 personal services and construction expenses, in a sum not to exceed
 4\$609,092.
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6 SECTION 10. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
 7 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
 8 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 9 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 10 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 11 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 12 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 13 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 14 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 15 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 16 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
 17 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

18 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
 19 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
 20 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
 21 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
 22 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
 23 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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25 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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34 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 35 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 36 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
