9 STATE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER

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13 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE -
14 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS GENERAL
15 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
22 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the
23 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
24 following:

25 (A) for HVAC upgrade to North End of State Capitol building, in a sum
26 not to exceed.....\$4,905,900.

27 (B) for rotunda interior dome painting and repair of the State Capitol
28 building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$989,622.

29 (C) for mural maintenance on the North and South ends of the State
30 Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$279,138.

31 (D) for centrifugal chillers for the State Capitol building, in a sum
32 not to exceed.....\$1,016,026.

33 (E) for roof and window repair of the State Capitol building, in a sum
34 not to exceed.....\$937,103.

35 (F) for asphalt resurfacing, replacement of damaged sidewalks and
36 curbs, addition of lighting to unlit or dark areas, an upgrade of the



- 1 irrigation system, and landscaping and plantings for the North Entry
- 2 Promenade I and II of the State Capitol Grounds, in a sum not to
- 3 exceed.....\$538,112.
- 4 (G) for drains and storm water system renovations of the State Capitol
- 5 Grounds, in a sum not to exceed.....\$483,000.
- 6 (H) for high efficiency boilers for the State Capitol building, in a
- 7 sum not to exceed.....\$397,613.
- 8 (I) for maintenance of State Capitol restroom facilities, in a sum not
- 9 to exceed.....\$318,887.
- 10 (J) for interior plumbing and sump pump replacement for the State
- 11 Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$108,393.
- 12 (K) for electrical panel replacement in the State Capitol building, in
- 13 a sum not to exceed.....\$212,980.
- 14 (L) for an IT department remodel including wiring and lighting in the
- 15 State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$131,897.
- 16 (M) for equipment upgrade of the existing fire alarm system for the
- 17 State Capitol Building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$193,446.
- 18 (N) for interior lighting efficiency improvement of the State Capitol
- 19 building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,826.
- 20 (O) for State Capitol as-built drawings, in a sum not to exceed
- 21\$109,250.

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23 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

24 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

25 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available

26 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

27 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

28 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

29 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State

30 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects

31 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds

32 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General

33 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

34 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

35 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing

36 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue

1 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
2 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
3 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
4 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
21 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
22 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
23 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
24 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
25 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
