8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE MILITARY  
9 DEPARTMENT FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS; AND FOR  
10 OTHER PURPOSES.

13 AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT  
14 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.

17  
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby  
21 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the  
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the  
23 following:

24 (A) for construction and renovation of the Camp Robinson Human  
25 Resources Office, in a sum not to exceed.....\$456,379.

26 (B) for construction of the Camp Robinson Sustainment and Restoration  
27 project, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

28 (C) for construction and renovation of armories for the Armory  
29 Rehabilitation Project Phase III, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

30 (D) for construction and renovation projects for ADA compliance, in a  
31 sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

32 (E) for construction of the Camp Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum  
33 not to exceed.....\$4,022,000.

34 (F) for construction and renovation of a Youth Program Facility, in a  
35 sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 2 the State Military Department, to be payable from the federal funds as  
 3 designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the following:

4 (A) for construction and renovation of the Searcy Field Maintenance  
 5 Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,407,510.

6 (B) for construction of the Fort Chaffee Live Fire/Entry Control Point,  
 7 in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,187,100.

8 (C) for construction and renovation of the Camp Robinson Human  
 9 Resources Office, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,369,136.

10 (D) for construction of the Camp Robinson Sustainment and Restoration  
 11 project, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

12 (E) for construction and renovation of armories for the Armory  
 13 Rehabilitation Project Phase III, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

14 (F) for construction and renovation projects for ADA compliance, in a  
 15 sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

16 (G) for construction of the Fort Chaffee Scout/Reconnaissance Infantry  
 17 Platoon Battle Course Overlay, in a sum not to exceed.....\$29,847,300.

18 (H) for construction of a Vehicle Washing Facility, in a sum not to  
 19 exceed.....\$1,365,120.

20 (I) for construction of the Camp Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum  
 21 not to exceed.....\$12,066,000.

22 (J) for construction of the Fort Chaffee Operational Readiness Training  
 23 Complex (ORTC), in a sum not to exceed.....\$40,710,880.

24 (K) for construction of the Professional Education Center (PEC)  
 25 Conferencing and Billeting Facility, in a sum not to exceed  
 26 .....\$54,000,000.

27 (L) for construction of the Fort Chaffee Sewer System, in a sum not to  
 28 exceed.....\$3,220,223.

29 (M) for construction of the Regional Training Institute Phase II, in a  
 30 sum not to exceed.....\$34,321,930.

31  
 32 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
 33 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
 34 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
 35 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
 36 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

1 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
 2 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
 3 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
 4 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
 5 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
 6 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
 7 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

8 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
 9 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
 10 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
 11 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
 12 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
 13 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

14  
 15 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23  
 24 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of  
 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm  
 31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
