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13 SECTION 10. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS ACCELERATION FUND. There is
 14 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority, to be
 15 payable from the Arkansas Acceleration Fund, for grants and incentives to
 16 accelerate the economy of the State through technology and knowledge-based
 17 development of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority - Arkansas
 18 Acceleration Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the following:

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24 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SEED
 26 CAPITAL INVESTMENTS. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary regarding
 27 general revenue year end fund balances, any monies received from the
 28 repayment of Seed Capital Investments authorized by the Arkansas Science and
 29 Technology Authority, shall be deposited into the State Treasury to the
 30 credit of the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account and shall remain in the
 31 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to be made available solely for the
 32 benefit of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority to provide
 33 additional Seed Capital Investments.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
 35 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

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1 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
3 FORWARD – TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT. The Arkansas Science and Technology
4 Authority is authorized to carry forward an amount of up to \$150,000 of any
5 obligated but unexpended funds in the Technology Development line item in
6 Section 3 for basic or applied research grants which remains at the end of
7 the fiscal year ~~2013~~ 2014 to be used for the same purpose.

8 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may
9 be carried forward under the following conditions:

10 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014 the Agency shall by written statement set
11 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
12 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

13 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
14 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
15 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
16 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
17 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
18 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
19 written request set forth in (1) above;

20 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
21 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
22 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
23 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
24 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
25 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
26 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
27 Committee; and

28 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
29 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
30 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
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32 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
34 BALANCE TRANSFER. Upon the effective date of this act, the available
35 balances received by the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority from
36 Client Services provided through the Arkansas Manufacturing Extension Network

1 – Federal appropriation, shall be transferred to the Arkansas Manufacturing
2 Extension Network – Cash Fund Account.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
4 through June 30, 2014.

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6 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
7 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
9 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
18 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
19 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
26 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
27 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
32 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
33 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
34 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
35 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
