## Subtitle

TO PERMIT CERTAIN PERSONS TO POSSESS A  
17 FIREARM IN A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE THAT  
18 SELLS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-  
19 PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND TO AMEND THE  
20 LAW CONCERNING FIREARMS.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24

25 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-403(21), concerning Class A alcoholic*  
26 *beverage permit violations, is amended to read as follows:*

27 *(21)(A) Possession of a weapon on the permitted premises by a*  
28 *person without a possessory or proprietary interest in the permitted*  
29 *premises.*

30

*(B) When the permitted premises is a retail liquor store*  
31 *that sells alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption, an employee of*  
32 *the retail liquor store that is licensed to carry a concealed handgun by the*  
33 *state may possess a handgun on the permitted premises if the possession of*  
34 *the handgun is permitted under state law.*
