18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-45-103 is amended to read as follows:

21 14-45-103. Vacancies.

22 ~~The town council shall have power to fill vacancies which may occur in~~
23 ~~elective offices of the town or on the council from qualified electors of the~~
24 ~~town, who shall hold their appointments until the next biennial election and~~
25 ~~until their successors are elected and qualified.~~ (a) When a vacancy occurs
26 in the office of alderman in an incorporated town, at the first regular
27 meeting after the occurrence of the vacancy, the town council shall elect by
28 a majority vote of the town council an alderman to serve for the unexpired
29 term.

30 (b) When a vacancy occurs in the office of mayor in an incorporated
31 town, at the first regular meeting after the occurrence of the vacancy, the
32 town council shall:

33 (1) Elect by a majority vote of the aldermen a mayor to serve
34 the unexpired term; or

35 (2)(A) Call for a special election to be held in accordance with
36 § 7-11-101 et seq. to fill the vacancy.
