8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF MEDICAID
10 INSPECTOR GENERAL WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1496 OF
12 2013; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF MEDICAID
16 INSPECTOR GENERAL SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
24 to the Office of Medicaid Inspector General, to be payable from the paying
25 account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal
26 services and operating expenses of the Office of Medicaid Inspector General
27 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in
28 Section 6 of Act 1496 of 2013, the following:

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6 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

7 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

9 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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16 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

18 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

19 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

26 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of

27 the Office of Medicaid Inspector General are, due to unforeseen

28 circumstances, insufficient for the Office of Medicaid Inspector General to

29 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of

30 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Office of Medicaid

31 Inspector General to continue such services; and that a delay in the

32 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper

33 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,

34 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the

35 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in

36 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

1 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
2 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
3 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
4 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
5 overrides the veto.
