4	(1) All licensed employees in public schools who are normally
5	expected to work nine hundred (900) hours or more per year, whose salaries
6	are paid from the school district's teacher salary fund, and all other
7	employees of public schools who are normally expected to work nine hundred
8	(900) hours or more per year and whose salaries are paid from the school
9	district's local or state revenue; and
10	(2)(A) All other employees of the school district whose salaries

30	(a) For the purposes of this section, a full-time school bus driver

36	vear is obtained by operating a school bus for a public school district: or

5	(b) All full-time school bus drivers who are not under current law	
6	eligible to participate in the public school employees insurance program	
7	provided for by §§ 6-17-1109 and 6-17-1111 — 6-17-1115 shall hereafter be	
8	eligible to participate in the program provided that they pay all costs	
9	associated with participating in the program unless the employing school	
10	district opts to pay all or a portion of that cost.

12	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective	
13	on and after January 1, 2015.	
14		
15	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the State and Public School	
17	Life and Health Insurance Program requires fundamental restructuring to	
18	ensure that affordable health insurance options are available to state and	
19	public school employees; that an urgent need exists to start implementing the	
20	necessary reforms to the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance	
21	Program; and that Section 1 of this act is immediately necessary to improve	
22	the financial viability of the State and Public School Life and Health	
23	Insurance Program. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and Section	
24	1 of this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public	
25	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:	
26	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;	
27	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,	
28	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the	
29	bill; or	
30	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
31	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
