8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE ARKANSAS
10 COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON LAW
15 ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING
16 REAPPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
23 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
24 and Training, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
25 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Commission on Law
26 Enforcement Standards and Training the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for various maintenance, renovation,
29 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, operational expenses,
30 upgrade and repair of real property and facilities of the Arkansas Commission
31 on Law Enforcement Standards & Training (ALETA), in a sum not to exceed
32\$500,000.

33 (B) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for major maintenance, renovation,
35 and repair of the ALETA - East Camden North Dormitory, in a sum not to exceed
36\$525,000.



1 (C) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for the replacement of heat and air
3 units, in a sum not to exceed.....\$85,000.

4 (D) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for the purchase of an automatic
6 transfer switch, wiring, and connections for ALETA - East Camden, in a sum
7 not to exceed.....\$20,000.

8 (E) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
9 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for the addition, renovation, and
10 replacement of existing buildings for ALETA - East Camden, in a sum not to
11 exceed.....\$210,000.

12 (F) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for the purchase of kitchen and
14 physical fitness equipment, in a sum not to exceed.....\$55,000.

15 (G) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for the purchase of the MILO
17 Computerized Shooting Simulator Training System, in a sum not to exceed
18\$70,000.

19 (H) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 39 of 2014, for new construction, improvement,
21 and equipment costs for the ALETA - Firing Range - East Camden, in a sum not
22 to exceed.....\$1,600,000.

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24 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
25 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
26 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
27 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
28 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
29 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
30 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
31 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
32 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
33 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
34 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
35 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

36 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing

1 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
 2 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
 3 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
 4 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
 5 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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 7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 16 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
