## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY  
15 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016  
16 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Mid-South Community College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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18 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

19 the Mid-South Community College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following

20 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra

21 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred

22 (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to

23 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or

24 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

27 appropriated, to the Mid-South Community College, to be payable from the Mid-

28 South Community College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of

29 the Mid-South Community College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the

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8 SECTION 6. ALLOCATIONS - ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS. There is  
 9 hereby allocated to the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium  
 10 (ADTEC) Partners and University Center Partners the following amounts of the  
 11 funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act, there to be used as provided by  
 12 in this Act, for the period ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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26 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

28 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS - TRAINING CONSORTIUM ADVICE. The Mid-South  
 29 Community College upon counsel with and advice from the Arkansas Delta  
 30 Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC) shall disburse funds from the  
 31 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS appropriation authorized in this Act to  
 32 selected University Center Partners and also the participating ADTEC  
 33 Partners.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
 35 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

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 2 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 3 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 8 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 9 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 10 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 11 with in disbursement of said funds.  
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13 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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22 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
 24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
 26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
 29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
