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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 2015-2016
26 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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10 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 12 HELP – STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of
 13 Education - Educational Television Division – State Operations for the ~~2014-~~
 14 ~~2015~~ 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or
 15 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 16 appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time
 17 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the
 19 appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific
 20 projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from
 21 limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~

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9 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 11 HELP – CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of
 12 Education - Educational Television Division - Cash Operations for the ~~2014-~~
 13 ~~2015~~ 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or
 14 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 15 appropriated herein for such purposes: forty-six (46) temporary or part-time
 16 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 17 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the
 18 appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific
 19 projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from
 20 limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 22 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

 11 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television
 12 Division, to be payable from the Educational Television Fund Account, for
 13 personal services and operating expenses for the "Arkansas Veterans'
 14 Initiative" documentation project of the Department of Education -
 15 Educational Television Division for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the
 16 following:

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22 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ~~HONORING~~
 24 ~~ARKANSAS' WAR HEROES.~~ ARKANSAS VETERANS' INITIATIVE. The appropriation
 25 authorized in this Act for ~~Honoring Arkansas' War Heroes~~ Arkansas Veterans'
 26 Initiative, Stories of Service is not intended to be carried forward into the
 27 base level for the purposes of budget preparation. Any appropriation request
 28 for this purpose shall be considered a new appropriation request, and
 29 therefore will be considered a change level budget request.

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31 Notwithstanding any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund
 32 balances or any law to the contrary, any funds provided to the Educational
 33 Television Fund Account for the purpose of funding the ~~Honoring Arkansas' War~~
 34 ~~Heroes~~ Arkansas Veterans' Initiative Appropriation which remain in the
 35 Educational Television Fund Account at the end of a fiscal year shall remain
 36 in the Educational Television Fund Account and shall continue to be allocated
 to the ~~Honoring Arkansas' War Heroes~~ Arkansas Veterans' Initiative

1 Appropriation in the following fiscal year.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
 3 through June 30, 2016.

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 5 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 6 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 7 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 8 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 15 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 24 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 25 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 26 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
 31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
