21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104(d)(1), concerning hunting and
24 fishing licenses for residents, is amended to read as follows:

25 (d)(1) The commission:

26 (A) Shall provide for the issuance of a lifetime hunting
27 and fishing license, with an optional lifetime trout stamp and lifetime state
28 duck stamp, to a resident of this state who is:

29 (i) Sixty-five (65) years of age or older for a one-
30 time fee of thirty-five dollars and fifty cents (\$35.50);

31 ~~(ii) [Repealed.]~~

32 ~~(iii)~~ (ii) Any age for a one-time fee of one thousand
33 dollars (\$1,000); or

34 ~~(iv)~~ (iii) Sixty (60) years of age or older who is a
35 regular or nonregular retiree of the armed services of the United States for
36 a one-time fee of thirty-five dollars and fifty cents (\$35.50); and



1 (B) May provide for the issuance of:

2 (i) A lifetime hunting-only license or a lifetime
3 fishing-only license for a fee that shall not exceed the fee that the
4 resident would be charged otherwise for the issuance of a lifetime license
5 under subdivision (d)(1)(A) of this section;

6 (ii) An annual resident sportsman hunting license to
7 a resident of the state who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older for a
8 fee not to exceed three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50);

9 (iii) An annual resident fishing license to a
10 resident of the state who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older for a fee
11 not to exceed three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50); and

12 (iv) An annual resident combination hunting and
13 fishing license to a resident of the state who is sixty-five (65) years of
14 age or older for a fee not to exceed four dollars and fifty cents (\$ 4.50).
