35	SECTION 2. Arkansa	as Code § 8-9-403(d)(2), concerning	regulations for		
36	the operation of waste tire sites, is amended to read as follows:				

1	(2) The regulations shall:		
2	(A) Provide for the administration of waste tire		
3	processing facility permits and a fee for each permit which shall not exceed		
4	two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) annually;		
5	(B) Provide for the administration of waste tire		
6	transporter licenses, waste tire collection center permits, and a fee for		
7	each permit which shall not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) annually;		
8	(C) Set standards for waste tire processing facilities,		
9	waste tire collection centers, and waste tire transporters;		
10	(D)(i) Establish procedures for administering the waste		
11	tire grant program and issuing grants.		
12	(ii)(a) The procedures established under subdivision		
13	(d)(2)(D)(i) of this section shall provide that a solid waste management		
14	district shall apply only one (1) time for a waste tire grant under this		
15	subchapter.		
16	(b) The application authorized under		
17	subdivision (d)(2)(D)(ii)(a) of this section shall suffice for each grant		
18	required under § 8-9-405(c)(3); and		
19	(E) Authorize the final disposition of waste tires at a		
20	permitted solid waste disposal facility, provided the tires have been cut		
21	into sufficiently small parts to assure their proper disposal.

23	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 8-9-405(c)(3), concerning waste tire		
24	grants, is amended to read as follows:		
25	(3) $\underline{(A)}$ Distribution of grant funds shall be based upon moneys		
26	available in the fund and upon approved submitted quarterly financial		
27	reports.		
28	(B) The reports shall show funds expended on waste tire		
29	projects during the previous quarter and expenses expected on waste tire		
30	projects during the next quarter and any other information as determined by		
31	the department.		
32	(C) Accordingly, and upon department approval, quarterly		
33	Quarterly distributions shall be made to the boards.
