14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION
15 CENTER APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016
16 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Crime Information Center for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

35 There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Crime Information Center, to be
 36 payable from the Crime Information System Fund, for maintenance and operating

1 expenses of the Arkansas Crime Information Center - Arkansas Real-Time Scrap
 2 Metal Logbook for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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8 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
 10 CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AND FUNDING. In the event additional appropriation
 11 becomes necessary that is not authorized or contemplated in Section 2 of this
 12 Act and circumstances make it necessary for the Arkansas Crime Information
 13 Center to request additional appropriation to carry out the objectives of the
 14 Agency, the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be used for
 15 regular salaries, personal services matching and maintenance and general
 16 operation line item appropriations authorized for such programs in this Act.
 17 Funding for the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be
 18 transferred to the appropriate fund or fund account from such excess funds as
 19 the Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center may determine are
 20 available from criminal background check fees deposited on behalf of the
 21 Arkansas Crime Information Center. Use of the contingency appropriation and
 22 funding authorized in this Act shall be approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer
 23 of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

24 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
 25 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
 26 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 27 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 28 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 29 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 30 has determined that the Arkansas Crime Information Center may operate more
 31 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Crime Information
 32 Center authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
 33 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
 34 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 35 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
 36 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.

1 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
2 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
3 this entire section is void.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
5 2015 through June 30, 2016.

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7 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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17 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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26 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
31 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015
