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SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic Recruitment Plan.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -20142015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

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SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AWARDS FUND TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, overtime, personal services matching, agency operational needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Provided however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund shall be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the Department of Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent with governing federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1 Joint Budget Committee.

2 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 3 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 4 5 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 6 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 7 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 8 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 9 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 10 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 11 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 12 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 13 14 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 15 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 16 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 17 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201419 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, 24 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to 25 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds 26 Transfer" to the Overtime, Personal Services Matching, and Maintenance and 27 General Operations classifications established in the operations 28 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may be used for 29 overtime, personal services matching, motor vehicle purchases and associated 30 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational 31 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. 32 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department 33 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as 34 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section. 35 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval 36 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

1 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 2 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 3 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 4 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 5 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 6 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 7 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 8 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 9 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 10 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 11 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 12 Committee as provided by this section. MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND — MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

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SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be

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SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS WIRELESS INFORMATION NETWORK. Once the requirements of Arkansas Code §12-8-18 19 310 are satisfied, the second two million dollars (\$2,000,000) deposited into 20 the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund generated by Arkansas Code §27-16-801(a) shall be used for the operations, maintenance, equipment and 21 22 various system requirements and expenses of the Department of Arkansas State 23 Police - Arkansas Wireless Information Network.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 25 2015 through June 30, 2016.

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SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1	SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
