Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas Building Authority may operate more

- 17 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
- of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) from
- 19 Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to the
- 20 Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the
- 21 appropriations herein.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 23 2015 through June 30, 2016.

- 25 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
- 27 TRANSFER. The Arkansas Building Authority is authorized to transfer any
- 28 unspent funds remaining in any cash fund account established for the
- 29 management of a state owned facility managed by, but not owned by, the
- 30 Arkansas Building Authority to the Arkansas Building Authority Maintenance
- 31 Fund to support the facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 33 2015 through June 30, 2016.

- 35 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
  36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agence
  - authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
2	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
3	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
4	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
5	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
7	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9	SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
10	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
11	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
12	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
13	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
14	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
15	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
16	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
17	
18	SECTION 27. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
19	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
20	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
22	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
24	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
25	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
26	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
27	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
28	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
