23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1006(a)(1), concerning fingerprinting
26 by a law enforcement agency, is amended to read as follows:

27 (a)(1)(A) Immediately following an arrest for an offense, a law
28 enforcement official at the receiving criminal detention facility shall take,
29 or cause to be taken, the fingerprints and a photograph of the arrested
30 person if the offense is a felony or a Class A misdemeanor.

31 (B) A law enforcement official at the receiving criminal
32 detention facility shall not take fingerprints of the arrested person if:

33 (i) The arrest was for a probation violation; and

34 (ii) The arrested person's fingerprints are already
35 possessed by the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State
36 Police.
