8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 ARKANSAS HERITAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

12 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
13 HERITAGE REAPPROPRIATION.  
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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19 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - CONSERVATION  
20 TAX - AMENDMENT 75. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
21 Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Department of Heritage  
22 Fund Account, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - DAH Central  
23 Administration the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
25 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 119 of 2015, for Special Maintenance, in a sum  
26 not to exceed.....\$1,483,189.  
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28 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - NCRC GRANTS.  
29 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be  
30 payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust  
31 Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - DAH Central Administration  
32 the following:

33 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
34 in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management,  
35 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,  
36 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$723,762.



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SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH DELTA CULTURAL CENTER - NCRC GRANTS.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$350,000.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION -

NCRC GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,250,000.

SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH HISTORIC ARKANSAS MUSEUM COMMISSION -

NCRC GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Arkansas Museum, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Arkansas Museum the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$650,000.

SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH MOSAIC TEMPLARS CULTURAL CENTER - NCRC

GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars of America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic

1 Templars of America Center for African-American Culture and Business  
2 Enterprise the following:

3 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
4 in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management,  
5 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,  
6 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$350,000.

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8 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH OLD STATE HOUSE COMMISSION - NCRC  
9 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage  
10 - Old State House, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural  
11 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Old  
12 State House - Old State House the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
14 in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management,  
15 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,  
16 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$650,000.

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18 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION - NCRC  
19 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage  
20 - Natural Heritage Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and  
21 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas  
22 Heritage - Natural Heritage Commission the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
24 in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for grants for the acquisition, management,  
25 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,  
26 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,750,000.

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28 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH MOSAIC TEMPLARS CULTURAL CENTER -  
29 ACQUISITIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas  
30 Heritage - Mosaic Templars of America Center for African-American Culture and  
31 Business Enterprise, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
32 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -  
33 Mosaic Templars of America Center for African-American Culture and Business  
34 Enterprise the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 212 of 2015, for the purchase of the building

1 and land located at 906 Broadway Street in Little Rock, Arkansas, in a sum  
2 not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

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4 SECTION 10. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - CAPITAL  
5 IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
6 Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement  
7 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas  
8 Heritage the following:

9 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
10 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 212 of 2015, for maintenance, renovation,  
11 equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of real  
12 property, personal services, operating expenses and master plan development,  
13 in a sum not to exceed.....\$645,000.

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15 SECTION 11. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION - COUNTY  
16 COURTHOUSE RESTORATION GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
17 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation, to be payable from  
18 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
19 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation the following:

20 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
21 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 212 of 2015, for grants for the County  
22 Courthouse Restoration Program, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,250,000.

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24 SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH ARKANSAS ARTS COUNCIL - ARTS COUNCIL  
25 GRANT PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas  
26 Heritage - Arts Council, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or  
27 its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage  
28 - Arts Council the following:

29 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
30 in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 212 of 2015, for grants for Community Arts  
31 Development and Arts Education programs, in a sum not to exceed  
32 .....\$850,000.

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34 SECTION 13. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION - LAND  
35 ACQUISITION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas  
36 Heritage - Natural Heritage Commission, to be payable from the General

1 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department  
2 of Arkansas Heritage - Natural Heritage Commission the following:

3 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
4 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 212 of 2015, for land acquisition for and  
5 stewardship of the Department of Arkansas Heritage natural areas, in a sum  
6 not to exceed.....\$2,180,000.  
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8 SECTION 14. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - NONPROFIT  
9 ORGANIZATION GRANT - LOUISIANA PURCHASE STATUE. There is hereby  
10 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the  
11 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
12 Department of Arkansas Heritage the following:

13 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
14 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 414 of 2015, for a grant to a nonprofit  
15 organization for the construction of a bicentennial statue or monument in  
16 Arkansas' capitol city that commemorates Arkansas' role in the land survey of  
17 the Louisiana Purchase, which began in Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed  
18 .....\$75,000.  
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20 SECTION 15. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - CAPITAL  
21 IMPROVEMENT GRANTS FOR MUSEUMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
22 Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement  
23 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas  
24 Heritage the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
26 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 431 of 2015, for grants for maintenance and  
27 operations, construction, repairs and equipment for museums focused on  
28 science, technology, engineering and mathematics, in a sum not to exceed  
29 .....\$25,000.  
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31 SECTION 16. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - MATCHING  
32 GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas  
33 Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor  
34 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
36 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 646 of 2015, for matching grants for

1 construction, improvements, renovation, equipping, supplies, upgrades,  
2 operating expenses and maintenance for historical monuments, markers,  
3 structures, tours, and documents related to African American Arkansans, in a  
4 sum not to exceed.....\$10,000.

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6 SECTION 17. REAPPROPRIATION - DAH - HISTORIC PRESERVATION - ELKIN'S  
7 FERRY BATTLEFIELD. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
8 Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation, to be payable from the General  
9 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department  
10 of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
12 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 415 of 2015, for land acquisition and  
13 improvement of the historic Elkin's Ferry Battlefield near Prescott,  
14 Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,000.

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16 SECTION 18. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
17 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
18 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
19 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
20 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
21 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
22 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
23 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
24 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
25 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
26 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
27 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

28 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
29 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
30 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
31 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
32 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
33 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
34 otherwise by law.

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36 SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
2 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
3 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
10 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
11 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of  
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
14 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
15 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
16 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
17 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
18 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
19 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
