8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE STABILIZATION  
9 LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
10

11 **Subtitle**

12 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE  
13 STABILIZATION LAW OF ARKANSAS.  
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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19 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue  
20 Stabilization Law.  
21

22 SECTION 2. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 19-5-302(9)(B) concerning  
23 revenues for the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, is amended to add an  
24 additional subdivision to read as follows:

25 (vi) Civil penalties paid or recovered as set out in § 2-  
26 24-108(d)(2).  
27

28 *SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-401 is amended to read as follows:*  
29 *19-5-401. Allocations for fiscal year 2016-2017 and thereafter.*  
30 *Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and each fiscal year*  
31 *thereafter, the Treasurer of State shall transfer all remaining general*  
32 *revenues available for distribution on the last day of business in July 2016,*  
33 *and on the last day of business in each calendar month thereafter during the*  
34 *fiscal year to the various funds and fund accounts participating in general*  
35 *revenues in the proportions of the maximum allocation as the individual*  
36 *allocation to the fund or fund account bears to the total of the maximum*



1 allocation as provided in § 19-5-402 (a) and (b).

3 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 19-5-402 is amended to read as follows:

4 19-5-402. Maximum allocations of revenues for fiscal year 2016-2017 and  
5 thereafter.

6 (a)(i) The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations in the  
7 proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and fund accounts listed  
8 below until there has been transferred a total of five billion one hundred  
9 ninety-one million three hundred thirteen thousand four hundred forty dollars  
10 (\$5,191,313,440) or so much thereof as may become available; provided, that  
11 the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with  
12 each fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total of all such  
13 allocations set forth in this subsection:

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31 (a)(ii) Thirteen million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$13,800,000), or so  
32 much thereof as is available shall be included and added to the amount  
33 distributed in (a)(i) and shall be distributed by the Treasurer of State in  
34 monthly amounts with each allocation's proportion of the total of both (a)(i)  
35 and (a)(ii) to supplement the fund established as a set-aside in the 90<sup>th</sup>  
36 Session Projects Account of the General Improvement Fund in Section 3 (a)

1 (11) of Act 1147 of 2015 of the General Improvement Distribution Act, for  
 2 transfers, from time to time, to any fund or fund account authorized by the  
 3 General Assembly, or for transfers, from time to time, for projects in the  
 4 Executive Discretionary Division Section (3) (d) of Act 1147 of 2015, upon  
 5 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

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 7 (b) After making the maximum annual allocations provided for in subsection  
 8 (a) of this section, the Treasurer of State shall then make allocations from  
 9 the remaining general revenues available for distribution, as set forth in  
 10 this subsection, to the funds and fund accounts listed below until there has  
 11 been transferred a total of one hundred twenty-seven million nine hundred  
 12 eighty-six thousand five hundred sixty dollars (\$127,986,560) or so much  
 13 thereof that may become available; provided, that the Treasurer of State  
 14 shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with each fund or fund  
 15 account's proportionate part of the total of all such allocations set forth  
 16 in this subsection:

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34 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING  
 36 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal

1 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the  
2 State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of fifty million dollars  
3 (\$50,000,000) from the unobligated funds in the General Improvement Fund to  
4 supplement the fund established as a set-aside in the 90th Session Projects  
5 Account of the General Improvement Fund in Section 3 (a) (11) of Act 1147 of  
6 2015 of the General Improvement Distribution Act, for transfers, from time to  
7 time, to any fund or fund account authorized by the General Assembly, or for  
8 transfers, from time to time, for projects in the Executive Discretionary  
9 Division authorized in subsection (d) of Section 3 of Act 1147 of 2015, upon  
10 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

11  
12 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING  
14 TRANSFER. The Office of Attorney General shall deposit or transfer by check  
15 from time to time the sum of two million two hundred and seventy-two thousand  
16 three hundred and seventy-seven dollars (\$2,272,377) from unobligated cash  
17 funds received from court orders or settlement agreements for deposit to cash  
18 funds deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal  
19 Officer of the State for the Department of Veterans' Affairs for startup  
20 costs, construction, personal services and operating expenses associated with  
21 the North Little Rock Veterans' Home.

22  
23 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DUPLICATE  
25 ACTS. If HB1141 and SB129 of the 2016 Fiscal Session of the 90<sup>th</sup> General  
26 Assembly are both enacted and adopted by the 90<sup>th</sup> General Assembly in  
27 identical form, then the last Act passed or latest expression shall supersede  
28 the other.

29  
30 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
31 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's fiscal  
32 laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year, and that if the  
33 current legislative session is extended such that the 90-day period ends  
34 after July 1, 2016, the changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency  
35 is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the  
36 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective

1 on July 1, 2016.
