8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 HUMAN SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
14 SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF AGING AND ADULT SERVICES.

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21 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division
22 of Aging and Adult Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund
23 or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services
24 - Division of Aging and Adult Services the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 424 of 2015, for grants for construction,
27 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
28 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
29\$10,000.

30 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 424 of 2015, for grants for personal services
32 and operating expenses, construction, renovation, and the purchase of
33 equipment to provide various community-based senior services, including but
34 not limited to, congregate and home-delivered meals, client representation,
35 information and assistance, socialization, adult day care and transportation,
36 in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000.



1 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 424 of 2015, for grants for hospice providers
3 for construction, renovation, personal services, operating, purchase of
4 equipment, and major maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed
5\$15,000.

6 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 424 of 2015, for a grant to Area Agencies on
8 Aging for construction, renovation, personal services and operating expenses,
9 purchase of equipment, and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a
10 sum not to exceed.....\$20,000.

11 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 437 of 2015, for grants for construction,
13 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
14 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
15\$20,000.

16 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 636 of 2015, for grants for Meals on Wheels
18 providers for construction, renovation, personal services, operating
19 expenses, purchase of equipment and major maintenance expenses, in a sum not
20 to exceed.....\$10,000.

21 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 640 of 2015, for grants for construction,
23 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
24 and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a sum not to exceed
25\$20,000.

26 (H) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
27 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 792 of 2015, for grants to Area Agencies on
28 Aging for construction, renovation, personal services and operating expenses,
29 purchase of equipment, and major maintenance of Senior Citizen Centers, in a
30 sum not to exceed.....\$20,000.

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32 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

33 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division
34 of Administrative Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund
35 or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services
36 - Division of Administrative Services the following:

1 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 180 of 2015, for various maintenance,
3 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
4 repair of real property and facilities department-wide, in a sum not to
5 exceed.....\$2,300,000.
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7 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES.

8 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division
9 of Behavioral Health Services, to be payable from the General Improvement
10 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human
11 Services - Division of Behavioral Health Services the following:

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (E) Section 8 of Act 118 of 2015, for grants for Treatment Programs
14 for personal services and operating expenses, construction, improvements,
15 equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed
16\$10,000.

17 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (J) Section 8 of Act 118 of 2015, for a transfer to the Drug Abuse
19 Prevention and Treatment Fund for behavioral health services to the citizens
20 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

21 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
22 in Item (K) Section 8 of Act 118 of 2015, for a transfer to the Drug Abuse
23 Prevention and Treatment Fund for behavioral health services to the citizens
24 of the State of Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$90,000.

25 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (L) Section 8 of Act 118 of 2015, for grants for Alcohol and
27 Substance Abuse Prevention for personal services and operating expenses,
28 construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses,
29 in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.

30 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 635 of 2015, for a grant to a transitional
32 living shelter for women 18 or older who have been treated for a mental,
33 physical or emotional disability for personal services, operating expenses,
34 construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and maintenance expenses,
35 in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000.
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1 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF COMMUNITY SERVICE AND
2 NONPROFIT SUPPORT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human
3 Services - Division of Community Service and Nonprofit Support, to be payable
4 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for
5 the Department of Human Services - Division of Community Service and
6 Nonprofit Support the following:

7 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 118 of 2015, for grants to Community
9 Organizations which provide services to the poor for construction,
10 renovation, personal services and operating expenses, purchase of equipment,
11 and major maintenance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$6,500.
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13 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
14 SERVICES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services
15 - Division of Developmental Disabilities Services, to be payable from the
16 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
17 Department of Human Services - Division of Developmental Disabilities
18 Services the following:

19 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 183 of 2015, for costs associated with
21 demolition, construction, replacement, renovation, upgrade and addition of
22 facilities at the Booneville Human Development Center, in a sum not to exceed
23\$7,778,144.

24 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 425 of 2015, for grants to Human Development
26 Centers serving developmentally disabled individuals for personal services
27 and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation and
28 maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$50,000.

29 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 614 of 2015, for a grant to the Conway Human
31 Development Center serving developmentally disabled individuals for personal
32 services and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment,
33 renovation, and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$25,000.
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35 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES. There is
36 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services, to be payable from

1 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
2 Department of Human Services the following:

3 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (A) Section 10 of Act 118 of 2015, for the Department of Human
5 Services for personal services, operating expenses, and programmatic
6 materials for the Safe Haven Program, in a sum not to exceed.....\$57,996.

7 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (C) Section 10 of Act 118 of 2015, for various maintenance,
9 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
10 repair of real property and facilities department-wide, in a sum not to
11 exceed.....\$80,000.

12 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 642 of 2015, for grants for construction,
14 renovation, personal services, operating expenses, purchase of equipment and
15 major maintenance for After School Programs, in a sum not to exceed
16\$50,000.

17 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 820 of 2015, for a grant for personal services,
19 operating expenses, construction, renovation and the purchase of equipment to
20 the Hunger Relief Alliance for feeding the needy of the State of Arkansas, in
21 a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

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23 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES. There is
24 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of
25 Medical Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
26 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services -
27 Division of Medical Services the following:

28 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 182 of 2015, for grant payments of the Arkansas
30 Medicaid Program of the Department of Human Services - Division of Medical
31 Services - Grants, in a sum not to exceed.....\$90,000,000.

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33 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES. There is
34 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth
35 Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
36 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Human Services - Division of

1 Youth Services the following:

2 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (B) Section 3 of Act 118 of 2015, for grants to community based
4 programs and juvenile delinquency prevention programs for personal services
5 and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
6 and maintenance expenses, in a sum not to exceed.....\$50,000.

7 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 154 of 2015, for upgrades and improvements to
9 the surveillance systems at all juvenile detention facilities of the
10 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services, in a sum not to
11 exceed.....\$5,000,000.

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13 SECTION 9. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
14 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
15 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
16 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
17 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
18 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
19 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
20 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
21 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
22 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
23 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
24 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

25 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
26 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
27 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
28 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
29 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
30 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
31 otherwise by law.

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33 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
2 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
3 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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6 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
8 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
9 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
12 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
13 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
14 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
15 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
16 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
