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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

15 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
 16 State Game and Fish Commission for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following
 17 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 18 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred
 19 eighty-five (185) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of
 20 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 21 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 22 classification.

24 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 25 to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game
 26 Protection Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
 27 State Game and Fish Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the
 28 following:

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24 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUNTERS
 26 FEEDING THE HUNGRY. Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry is designed to share
 27 the harvest of an abundant resource with Arkansans who are in need of food,
 28 partner with the Game and Fish Commission in order to provide a solution for
 29 a healthy, balanced deer herd, provide a much needed free, low fat, high
 30 protein food source to the many feeding agencies and organizations across
 31 Arkansas and create a provider purpose for hunters who participate, allowing
 32 them to give back and share with others. In order to help sustain the
 33 Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry program in Arkansas the Arkansas Game and
 34 Fish Commission may establish a check off or other appropriate methods to
 35 raise revenue for support of the program. The intent of this Section is to
 36 encourage the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission to examine opportunities

1 available to provide support for the Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry
2 program.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
4 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

5

6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT
8 OF REWARDS. Payment of rewards shall be from the Game Protection Fund from
9 the Commission's Maintenance and General Operation appropriation as herein
10 appropriated in Section 3, Item No. (06)(A).

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
12 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

13

14 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
16 HELP RESTRICTION. No employee of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission who is
17 employed as extra help may receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent
18 (85%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized
19 under § 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such an employee
20 be employed for a period of time to exceed one thousand eight hundred (1,800)
21 hours in any single fiscal year.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
23 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

24

25 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
27 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
28 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
29 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line
30 item authorized in Section 3 Operations to any other line item authorized in
31 Section 3 and the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any
32 line item authorized in Section 4 Gas Lease Revenues to any other line item
33 authorized in Section 4.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
35 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

1 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
3 The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission is hereby authorized to make overtime
4 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
5 those wildlife officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may
6 be assigned by the Director of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission or by an
7 appointed designate to Special Law Enforcement Task Forces, Special
8 Operations, and other special programs reimbursable to the Arkansas Game and
9 Fish Commission by federal or local authorities as approved by the Director
10 of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. All such overtime payments shall
11 be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be in addition to
12 the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee(s). Payment of
13 overtime is the preferred method of implementing the provisions of this
14 section.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
16 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

17
18 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT
20 OF ACCRUED LEAVE. The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission is hereby authorized
21 to pay all accrued and unused annual, holiday, and sick leave to the estate
22 of any wildlife officer who dies in the line of duty. Such payments are
23 subject to budgetary constraints and shall be disbursed after receipt of the
24 official death certificate.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, ~~2015~~2016
26 through June 30, ~~2016~~2017.

27
28 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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
