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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the 2017-
25 2018 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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8 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

9 the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the 2017-

10 2018 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary

11 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated

12 herein for such purposes: eighty (80) temporary or part-time employees, when

13 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform

14 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the

15 appropriate classification.

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17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby

18 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich

19 Mountain, to be payable from the University of Arkansas Community College at

20 Rich Mountain Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the

21 University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain for the fiscal year

22 ending June 30, 2018, the following:

 34 is amended to read as follows:

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36 The following state-supported institutions of higher education shall be

1 exempt as allowed by § 19-4-1415(b)(5) for construction projects exceeding
 2 five million dollars (\$5,000,000) if they have adopted policies and
 3 procedures in compliance with state law involving the awarding and oversight

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26 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code 19-4-
 27 906(a) is amended to read as follows:

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29 (a) None of the funds appropriated for the various state agencies,
 30 authorities, boards, commissions, departments, and institutions of higher
 31 education listed below shall be used to purchase, lease for over thirty (30)
 32 days, operate, repair, or provide services for more than the maximum number
 33 of passenger motor vehicles as set out in this section, except in an
 34 emergency as proclaimed by the Governor. Passenger motor vehicles are defined
 35 as those licensed for highway use, including, but not limited to,
 36 automobiles, trucks, and vans. Mileage reimbursement for employees'

1 utilization of their personal automobiles shall not be deemed to be included
2 in this restriction.

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7 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(r)
8 is amended to read as follows:

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10 (q) University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community
11 College Fund.

12 (1) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor
13 of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the
14 "University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community College
15 Fund".

16 (2) The University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community
17 College Fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of
18 the University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community
19 College.

20 (3) The University of Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community
21 College Fund shall consist of:

- 22 (A) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and
- 23 (B) Any other funds made available for the support of the University of
24 Arkansas Community College at Rich Mountain Community College which are
25 required to be deposited into the State Treasury by law.

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27 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code 19-11-
28 220(a) is amended to read as follows:

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30 (a) In addition to any state agency authorized by regulation to have an
31 agency procurement official, each of the following state agencies may elect
32 to have such an official for commodities, technical and general services, and
33 professional and consultant services, which are not within the exclusive
34 jurisdiction of the State Procurement Director and which are not under state
35 contract:

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 4 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 7 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 13 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 15 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 24 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 25 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 26 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
 31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
