14 AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
15 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.
16

17
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -
21 GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State
22 University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
23 fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas State University the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for construction of a Humanities and
26 Social Sciences Building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$209,380.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (C) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for renovation of Wilson Hall, in a
29 sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (D) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for construction of a Studio Arts
32 addition to the College of Fine Arts, in a sum not to exceed
33\$3,000,000.

34 (D) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (E) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for renovation of the International
36 Student Center building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000,000.



1 (E) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (F) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
3 not to exceed.....\$4,620,000.

4 (F) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (G) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for the purchase, replacement, and
6 renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed
7\$2,273,164.

8 (G) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided

10 maintenance, equipment, personal services and operating expenses of the
11 various institutions and entities of the Arkansas State University System, in
12 a sum not to exceed.....\$15,000,000.

13 (H) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (I) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for construction, renovation,
15 maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,
16 technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to
17 exceed.....\$500,000.

18 (I) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (K) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for remodeling, renovation,
20 refurbishing, equipment, furnishings, replacement of
21 plumbing/electrical/heating and cooling systems, and exhibit expenses of
22 Lakeport Plantation facilities, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000.

23 (J) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (N) Section 5 of Act 18 of 2016, for capital improvements including
25 completion of theatre reconstruction, parking and landscaping at Colony
26 Center, adjacent outdoor stage, parking at Cash home, construction of
27 outbuildings, including barn for classrooms and restrooms, and colony house
28 to be used for *security/maintenance, personal services and operating*
29 *expenses*, in a sum not to exceed.....\$75,000.

31 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -
32 NCRC - V.C. KAYS HOUSE HERITAGE SITE. There is hereby appropriated, to the
33 Arkansas State University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
34 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas State University
35 System the following:

36 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (01) Section 24 of Act 253 of 2016, for acquisition, management,
2 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
3 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$181,935.

5 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY - GENERAL
6 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Tech University,
7 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund

14 Technology on the Ozark Campus, in a sum not to exceed.....\$177,713.

17 and Academic Support building roof on the Ozark Campus, in a sum not to
18 exceed.....\$787,549.

21 improvements and upgrades, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,500,000.

24 maintenance of educational and general buildings, in a sum not to exceed
25\$1,935,716.

26 (F) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided

29 (G) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided

 18 As referenced in SECTION 3, subsection (c) of Act 1147 of 2015, the
 19 authorized funding for the Arkansas State University for capital improvements
 20 including completion of theatre reconstruction, parking and landscaping at
 21 Colony Center, adjacent outdoor stage, parking at Cash home, construction of
 22 outbuildings, including barn for classrooms and restrooms, and colony house
 23 to be used for security/maintenance shall also be deemed to include personal
 24 services and operating expenses.

25
 26 SECTION 23. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
 27 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
 28 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 29 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 30 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 31 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 32 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 33 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 34 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 35 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 36 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

1 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

2 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
3 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
4 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
5 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
6 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
7 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
8 otherwise by law.

9
10 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18
19 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
21 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
25 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
28 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
